# 條款及細則

### 報名前請仔細閱讀以下活動條款及細則。

### 報名須知

- 1. 報名人士必須於網上報名同時繳交籌款,方能保證參與資格。
- 2. 報名將以先到先得方式決定參加資格,額滿即止。
- 3. 16 歲或以下參加者需獲家長/監護人簽署同意方可參加。
- 4. 捐款收據將以電郵方式發送至報名捐款者。請在表格上清楚填寫資料。
- 5. 如天文台於活動當日早上 6 時或之後懸掛三號或以上風球或黃 / 紅 / 黑色暴雨警告訊號·是次活動將會取消·已繳交之款項恕不退回。
- 6. 生命熱線(本會)保留取錄參加者及活動安排之最終決定權。
- 7. 本會有權隨時修改此條款及細則而無須另行通知。
- 8. 關於活動之一切事宜,本會有最終決定權,請留意本會最新公布。

### 活動須知

- 1. 本會將於電郵確認函件 (包括活動詳情及穿梭巴士時間) 予個人參加者 / 各隊隊長·請隊長將相關資料通知及轉發給各隊員。活動當日不設現場報名。

- 5. In case of typhoon signal No.3 or above, or amber / red / black rainstorm warning is hoisted at or after 6am on event date by the Hong Kong Observatory, the event will be canceled and donation will NOT be refunded.
- 6. The Organiser, Suicide Prevention Services (SPS), reserves the right to the final decision on acceptance of applications and to change the event details without prior notice.
- 7. SPS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions at any time without prior notice.
